

## **COVID-19 Summer Camp Plan**

In collaboration with state and local health officials, we have come up with the following guidelines to ensure the safety of all our campers.

### **Coaches:**

1. All Beestera Staff have been trained in the COVID-19 Guidelines
  - a. No staff will show up if they have or had any of the COVID-19 symptoms in the past 14 days
  - b. No staff will show up if they have come in contact with someone who has experienced symptoms of COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
2. All staff will be screened with Infrared Thermometers before camp.
3. Groups will be a maximum of 10 campers.
  - a. The coach will sanitize all equipment and anything else used directly after.
4. Campers will stay with the same coach throughout the whole day.
5. Coaches will “pre-screen” by reaching out to parents via survey so questions pertaining to exposure to COVID-19 can be answered.
  - a. If a coach or camper has been exposed to or has had any COVID-19 symptoms in the past 14 days, they will not be allowed to participate.
  - b. If a parent does not fill out the survey, their child will not be allowed to participate.

### **Player Entry:**

1. All campers will enter from a designated entrance (signs will be up).
2. Campers and Parents are required to wear masks as they enter the facility.
3. All campers will be screened with contactless thermometers right as they are dropped off.
4. There will be social distancing markings on the floor to encourage 6 ft while checking in.
5. All players must wash their hands or use hand sanitizer (which will be provided) before coming onto the field.
6. All players will go directly to their assigned coach after signing in to minimize contact with other groups.
7. Each camp group will have a designated spot to drop their belongings before camp starts.

### **During the Camp:**

1. All coaching will be done from 6 feet of distance.
  - a. If a coach needs to come within 6 feet of a player, they will put on their mask.
2. Campers will keep 6 ft of distance when possible.
3. Everytime a camper coughs or sneezes they will be required to wash their hands or use hand sanitizer.
4. If any player experiences COVID-19 symptoms during the camp, their parents will be immediately notified to come get them and that whole group will have to go home and will not be allowed to come back to a camp for a minimum of 14 days.

5. Lunch and snack breaks will be staggered so campers do not interact with other campers from different groups.
6. Staff will sanitize all tables, chairs, and benches after each break.
7. Staff will sanitize all equipment between activities.
8. Campers and coaches will stay in their groups throughout the whole week and will not be allowed to switch.

**Player Exit:**

1. All campers and parents will sign their child out from their designated area (signs will be posted).
2. All campers and parents will be required to wear a mask as they are leaving in case they find themselves in close proximity to someone else.
3. All players must sanitize their hands before leaving the camp.

**Coaches Leaving the Facility:**

1. Coaches will wipe down all equipment before putting it away.
2. All door handles, tables, chairs or anything else used will be sanitized before leaving the facility.

**In the Event of Bad Weather:**

1. Each facility has enough rooms where we can have all campers and coaches take shelter while still keeping the appropriate distance.
  - a. All campers and coaches will be required to wear masks during this time.
